GUIDELINE FOR FORMAL DRESSES

1. No cleavage...must be covered with heavy nude fabric. All necklines must be either straight across or filled in appropriately. (No mesh)

2. No 2 piece dresses that show skin around the midsection or dresses with sides cut out.

3. Slit up the side must be no more than mid-thigh. Hems and slits NO more than 3 inches above the knee; including dresses with long sheer overskirts.

4. If there is a bare back it must end at the waist.

5. The Formal Dress Submission Form must be filled out. It is available on our website at: https://weirtonmadonna.org/formal-dress-submission-form/. Three pictures of the student with face in the dress (front, side and back view) must be included for approval by the committee before any tickets are purchased.

6. If questionable, you may be asked to bring your dress in for approval.

7. Upon arrival at the dance, if the dress does not match the email print out or has been altered you will be asked to leave.

8. **FOR ALL STUDENTS**: Clothing must remain intact and in its proper place. No attire is to be altered once students are admitted into the dance. All rules apply to Madonna students and guests.
